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Scope of Works

TLILIC0003 - LICENCE TO OPERATE A FORKLIFT TRUCK – 3 days

This unit specifies the outcomes required for the operation of a powered industrial truck equipped with a mast and an elevating load carriage to which is attached a pair of fork arms or other attachment, for licensing purposes.

TLILIC0005 - LICENCE TO OPERATE A BOOM-TYPE ELEVATING WORK PLATFORM (boom length 11 metres or more) – 3 days

This unit specifies the outcomes required to operate a boom-type elevating work platform (boom length 11 metres or more) for licensing purposes, and involves the operation of a telescoping device, hinged device, or articulated device or any combination of these used to support a platform on which personnel, equipment and materials may be elevated to perform work.

CPCCLDG3001 - LICENCE TO PERFORM DOGGING – 4 days

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to safely perform dogging work. Dogging consists of the application of slinging techniques to move a load, including the selection and inspection of lifting gear, and the directing of a plant operator in the movement of a load when the load is out of sight of the operator.

RIIWHS204E - WORK SAFELY AT HEIGHTS – 1 day

This unit covers working safely at heights. It includes: identifying the work requirements, work procedures and instructions for the task; accessing and installing equipment; performing work at heights; and cleaning up the work area.

RIIWHS202E - ENTER AND WORK IN CONFINED SPACES – 1 day

This unit covers the entering and working in confined spaces. It includes planning and preparing for entry of confined spaces, entry and working in confined spaces, exiting confined spaces and cleaning up.

TLILIC0023 - LICENCE TO OPERATE A SLEWING MOBILE CRANE (up to 60 tonnes) – 5 days

This unit specifies the outcomes required to operate a slewing mobile crane (up to 60 tonnes) for licensing purposes. It encompasses the requirement for non-slewing mobile crane licence and the vehicle loading crane licence.

CONFINED SPACES COURSE – 6 Units of Competence – 2 Days

This course includes 6 units of competence and is designed for individuals in operational roles who may be required to work in confined spaces, issue work permits or perform standby or supervisor duties for confined spaces. It includes planning and preparing, applying for a permit, hazard analysis, testing gas and maintaining equipment, controlling the permit site, entry and working in confined spaces, exiting confined spaces, cleaning up and completing permit paperwork.

RIIMPO318F - CONDUCT CIVIL CONSTRUCTION SKID STEER LOADER OPERATIONS

This unit covers conducting skid steer loader operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating skid steer loaders; lifting, carrying and placing materials; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the skid steer loaders; carrying out machine operator maintenance; and cleaning up.

RIIMPO320F - CONDUCT CIVIL CONSTRUCTION EXCAVATOR OPERATIONS

This unit covers the conduct excavator operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating the machine; lifting, carrying and placing materials; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the machine; carrying out machine operator maintenance; and cleaning up.

RIIMPO317F - CONDUCT ROLLER OPERATIONS

This unit covers the conducting roller operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; operating and relocating the machine; and carrying out operator maintenance and clean up.

RIIHAN309F - CONDUCT TELESCOPIC MATERIALS HANDLER OPERATIONS

This unit covers conducting telescopic handler operations in the resources and infrastructure industries. It includes: planning and preparing for operations; operating the telescopic handler; selecting, fitting, testing, using and removing attachments, and shifting loads; and carrying out post-operational procedures.

RIIMPO321E - CONDUCT CIVIL CONSTRUCTION WHEELED FRONT END LOADER OPERATIONS

This unit covers conducting wheeled front end loader operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating front end loaders; attaching, securing, lifting, carrying and placing materials; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the front end loader; carrying out machine operator maintenance; and cleaning up.

RIIMPO319E - CONDUCT BACKHOE/LOADER OPERATIONS

This unit covers the conducting backhoe / loader operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating backhoe / loaders; lifting, carrying and placing materials; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the backhoe / loaders; carrying out machine operator maintenance; and cleaning up.

RIIMPO322E - CONDUCT CIVIL CONSTRUCTION TRACKED FRONT END LOADER OPERATIONS

This unit covers conducting tracked front end loader operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating the machine; lifting, carrying and placing materials; relocating the machine; carrying out machine operator maintenance; and cleaning up.

RIIMPO323E - CONDUCT CIVIL CONSTRUCTION DOZER OPERATIONS

This unit covers conducting dozer operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating the machine; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the machine; carrying out machine operator maintenance; and cleaning up.

RIIMPO315E – CONDUCT TRACTOR OPERATIONS

This unit covers the conducting tractor operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing for tractor operations; operating tractors in line with established requirements to complete work activity; selecting, removing and using attachments; relocating the tractor; and Conduct housekeeping activities

RIIMPO324F - CONDUCT CIVIL CONSTRUCTION GRADER OPERATIONS

This unit covers conducting grader operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating the machine; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the machine; carrying out machine operator maintenance; and cleaning up.

RIIMPO326E - CONDUCT CIVIL CONSTRUCTION WATER CART OPERATIONS

This unit covers conduct water cart operations in the civil construction industry. It includes: planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating the water cart; loading, transporting and distributing water; carrying out driver maintenance; and cleaning up.

RIIMPO337E - CONDUCT ARTICULATED HAUL TRUCK OPERATIONS

This unit covers conducting haul truck operations in the resources and infrastructure industries. It includes: planning and preparing for operations; operating the haul truck; loading, hauling and dumping materials; and carrying out post-operational procedures.

RIIMPO338E - CONDUCT RIGID HAUL TRUCK OPERATIONS

This unit covers conducting haul truck operations in the resources and infrastructure industries. It includes: planning and preparing for operations; operating the haul truck; loading, hauling and dumping materials; and carrying out post-operational procedures.

RIIMPO325E CONDUCT CIVIL CONSTRUCTION SCRAPER OPERATIONS

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to operate a scraper to load, transport and discharge material, and to couple and relocate a scraper. It includes: planning and preparing for scraper operations, operating the scraper in line with established requirements to complete work activity, coupling machines to perform work activity, relocating the scraper and conducting housekeeping activities

RIIHAN305D – OPERATE A GANTRY OR OVERHEAD CRANE – 1 day

This unit describes a participant's skills and knowledge required to operate a gantry or overhead crane, including planning and preparing and performing operational servicing. It includes: planning and preparing for gantry/overhead crane operations, operating the gantry/overhead crane and performing gantry/overhead crane operator maintenance

RIIHAN301E OPERATE ELEVATING WORK PLATFORM – 1 day

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to operate an elevating work platform at any height. It includes: planning and preparing for operating an elevating work platform, operating an elevating work platform in line with established requirements to complete work activities and conducting housekeeping activities

RIIHAN308F - LOAD AND UNLOAD PLANT – 1 day

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to load and unload plant. Prior to performing this activity, skills and knowledge should be developed for the individual plant. This can be achieved through completing the equivalent operator unit or being assisted by someone who has this knowledge. It includes: preparing to load and unload plant, loading the plant in line with established requirements and unloading the plant in line with established requirements

RIIHAN307E - OPERATE A VEHICLE LOADING CRANE – 1 day

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to operate, maintain and shift loads using a vehicle loading crane. It includes: preparing for vehicle loading crane operations, operating the vehicle loading crane in line with established requirements to complete a work activity and conducting housekeeping activities

RIIHAN203E - CONDUCT LIFTING OPERATIONS – 1 day

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to conduct lifting operations in the resources and infrastructure industries, including developing preliminary lifting plans, directing load movements, connecting load to movement devices and confirming load stability. They generally work under supervision to undertake a prescribed range of functions involving known routines and procedures and take some responsibility for the quality of work outcomes. It includes: planning and preparing for lifting operations, preparing for lifting and moving loads

CPCCLRG3001 - LICENCE TO PERFORM RIGGING - BASIC LEVEL – 5 days

This unit specifies the outcomes required to perform basic rigging work associated with movement of plant and equipment, steel erections, hoists (including mast climbing hoists), placement of pre-cast concrete, safety nets and static lines, perimeter safety screens and shutters; and cantilever crane loading platforms for licensing purposes.

CPCCLRG3002 - LICENCE TO PERFORM RIGGING - INTERMEDIATE LEVEL – 5 days

This unit specifies the outcomes required to perform rigging work at the intermediate level, which includes all the outcomes for rigging work at the basic level, and also includes rigging of cranes, rigging of conveyors, rigging of dredges and excavators, rigging associated with tilt slabs, rigging associated with demolition work, and dual lifts for licensing purposes.

CPCCLRG4001 - LICENCE TO PERFORM RIGGING - ADVANCED LEVEL – 5 days

This unit specifies the outcomes required to perform rigging work at the advanced level, which includes all the outcomes for rigging work at the basic and intermediate levels, and also includes rigging of gin poles and shear legs, flying foxes and cable ways, guyed derricks and structures, and suspended scaffolds and fabricated hung scaffolds for licensing purposes.
